Thanksgiving Dinner Loaf

½ cup boiling water	2 tsp beef-like seasoning
2 ½ cup gluten flour (organic, if possible)	¼ cup nutritional yeast*
1/3 to ½ cup peanut or walnut butter	2 cups water
¼ cup No-Brag Mock Aminos** (or 3 Tbsp yeast paste)	

Preheat oven to 400°F (200°C). Combine wet ingredients, especially boiling water with nut butter. Combine dry ingredients. Mix together. Place in a prepared bread loaf pan and bake 15 minutes. Reduce to 350°F (175°C) and bake an additional 60 minutes. Let cool 20 minutes before slicing. Serve with gravy.

*May be replaced with 1 ½ Tbsp blended pumpkin seeds and 1 ½ Tbsp onion powder

gone, so was the barn. But soon his smile returned. Beside that field, on the back of a large road sign, scrawled in large white letters were the words: "I still love you, Kathy."



Most of us think, "Oh, how sweet. I wish somebody would do that for me." But each of us have a God who gives us tokens of His love every day. It all began with the token of the blood of the Lamb. In the first Passover the blood of the lamb was a token of God's protection to those who obediently applied it.

"And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt." Exodus 12:13

When Adam and Eve sinned, the first message of love in the gift of Eden was no longer accessible to mankind, but God sent His Son as a token/sign of God's continued love for mankind. 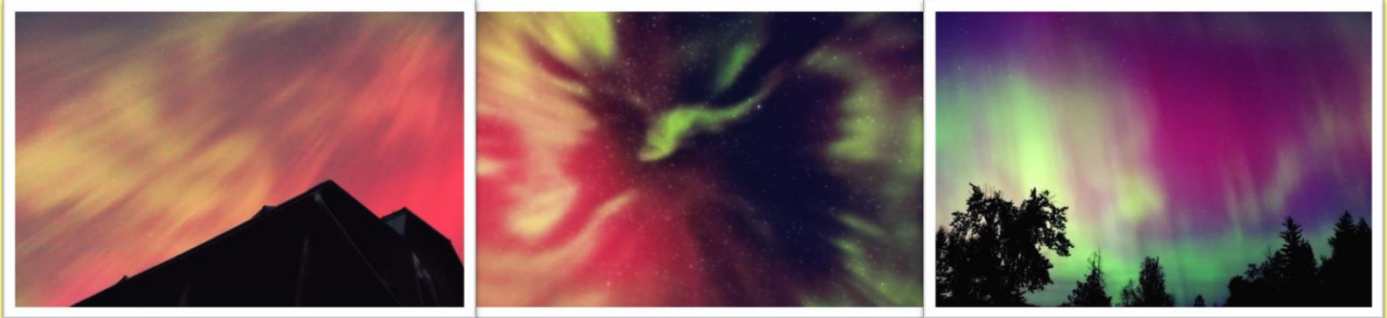

Natural Remedies an 8-year Old Can Do (Little Runners' Special)



If I burn my finger, what can I do to make it feel better and heal faster?



You can break open a leaf of the **aloe vera** plant and put the gel on the burn. Leaving the skin of the aloe on, helps to keep the gel from drying out.



You can also cover the burn in **honey** to help it heal.



What if my brother feels like he is **getting sick**, can I help him not to get sick?



You can use **water** treatments. Make sure he drinks lots of **water**.



Then give him a cold-mitten friction. Start by putting him under a blanket to keep him warm. Take out an arm or leg one at a time and rub it down with a cold cloth dipped in **ice water**. Don't forget to wring the cloth out good. Also dry his arm or leg with a towel before putting it back under the covers to keep warm. This will help his white blood cells to fight the disease better.



If my tummy hurts and I feel like throwing up, what can I do?



We could make some ginger tea out of ginger powder mixed in warm plant milk or water. It helps with nausea.

You would need to remember to drink plenty of water, but if it is hard to drink water, sometimes eating chipped ice is easier.



If the pain gets really bad we can blend 4-6 garlic cloves in a blenderful of water and add about 3-4 Tbsp of activated charcoal powder. When you drink this it helps to kill and absorb the bad stuff that is making your stomach hurt.



If I forget to wash a cut and it gets infected and red, what can I do?

You can crush a plantain leaf and make a poultice, or you can grate a potato and make a poultice to put over the red spot. It will pull out the infection.



If I get stung by a bee what can I do?

If you are a long way from the house, put mud or a plantain leaf on the sting. It will help absorb the poison. When you get back to the house you can mix charcoal and quick oats together with a little water to make a poultice to put on it.



Drinking activated charcoal water and something high in vitamin C like lemon water or orange juice is also helpful.

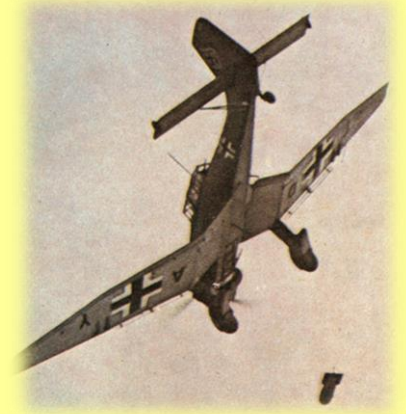
God often chooses insignificant people and events to bring about His great purposes. A story that took place in World War II shows how the smallest deed can make all the difference in the world to someone.

During the last months of the War, the British conducted daily bombing raids over Berlin and one night the bombers were attacked by a large group of German fighter planes.

During the dogfight one of the bomber planes got separated from the protection of British fighter planes. They watched helplessly as a German fighter plane came within range.

Bullets whizzed by over and over until Thud! Thud! Thud! Thud! Thud! Five bullets slammed into the fuselage of the bomber near the fuel tank.

The crew braced for the explosion, but it never came. Fuel poured from the bullet holes, but there was no explosion. After landing, a mechanic handed the pilot five bullets he had pulled from the plane.



The pilot carefully opened the explosive tip and found that they were empty --- except for a tiny wad of paper with a note that read: *"We are Polish POWs [prisoners of war] forced to make bullets. When guards do not look, we do not fill with explosive. Is not much, but is best we can do."*

Those five small bullets were made by a few weak and lowly prisoners. But because of the small effort of those prisoners every member of that British bomber crew made it home alive. It didn't seem like much to those POW's, but for the crew of that British bomber it made all the difference in the world.

We are prisoners of circumstance held hostage in a sinful world. Why not come up with a plan of something you can do this week to aid the cause of your Redeemer. Maybe you don't think you have much to give, but let me assure you that God can turn the smallest deed, just a token of your time, whatever you have, into life changing actions.

Greater flamingos live in parts of Africa, Western Asia, and Southern Europe. They are most often found in salt lakes, costal lagoons, and intertidal (meaning covered at high tide and uncovered at low tide) mudflats. The diet of greater flamingos consists of small invertebrates (animals, like snails, that don't have a backbone), microalgae, and plant seeds. One of the ways these birds forage or look for food is by stamping and lifting their legs rapidly while holding their unique bill close to filter the food out of the water. As Religious Liberty erodes, God's Word makes it into the News

Prophetic News Notes



Around the world religious liberty seems to be under fire. Now the punishment of a *“thought crime”* in the U.K. has made the news. The Washington Times reported, *“A British army veteran has now been convicted for silently praying outside an abortion clinic, in what experts are calling ‘a legal turning point of immense proportions’ for free speech and religious liberty in the U.K.”*¹

Apparently, due to a *“Public Spaces Protection Order,”* anything appearing to be anti-abortion is no longer allowed within a buffer zone around abortion clinics. *“Smith-Connor had slightly bowed his head and clasped his hands in prayer on a public green in a buffer zone...During a confrontation with police officers that he recorded, they asked him, ‘What is the nature of your prayer?’”*² Not being allowed to pray silently in a public space to the God of your choice is reminiscent of the decree

that got Daniel thrown into the Lion’s Den and also the time period of the Inquisition. In court, *“Defense attorneys argued that Smith-Connor’s prayerful thoughts, beliefs and opinions were not a crime, especially as he stood peacefully and silently on a public street. He stood behind a tree, spoke to no one and had his back to the facility.”*²

*“Sir Edward Leigh, ‘Father of the House of Commons,’ meaning the most senior Member of Parliament, expressed outrage at the outcome. “It is disgraceful that in Britain in 2024 someone can be put on trial for praying silently in his head,” Leigh said. ‘Unfortunately, we have seen repeated cases of free speech under threat in the U.K. when it comes to the expression of Christian beliefs. To offer a prayer silently in the depths of your heart cannot be an offense. The government must clarify urgently that freedom of thought is protected as a basic human right.’”*³



The good news is, in the midst of all the turmoil, God’s word still stands. After all the flooding from Hurricane Helene, a Bible was found on a fencepost reminding us of the promise, *“So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.”* Isaiah 55:11 Here is the transcribed report of those who found the Bible. *“So this Bible was found after the flood from Hurricane Helene on this fencepost. And it is on Revelation 14, 15. Of all the things destroyed that was left open. And it’s sitting there, and we’re not touching it. So this house was buried and flooded all the way to the roof originally. The man that lived here had to be rescued off of the roof by a raft. And they are just emptying, just demoing the entire house, and this Bible was found on a pole open to Revelation.”*⁴ Someone commented on the video stating, *“I would like to see the details of how is attached to the pole.”*⁴ The person who posted the video replied, *“I am back home, but it seems to be the starch from the paper and the water glued it there. I cannot confirm.”*⁴ Interesting isn’t it? As if recommending a certain message of importance, this Bible was basically pasted open to the message of the three angels of Revelation 14! Zooming in on the picture, I could read the KJV narration of all three messages. *“Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come... Babylon is fallen, is fallen”* and *“If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, the same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God...Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.”* (Rev. 14:7-12) Indeed, with the paper made from their pulp, we can almost hear, *“the trees of the wood sing out at the presence of the LORD, because he cometh to judge the earth.”* 1Chr. 16:33 It’s time to be ready!
